A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS MADE OUT OF THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET
RESERVE FUND PURSUANT TO ACT 191, SESSION LAWS OF HAWAII
2010.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Pursuant to Act 191, Session Laws of Hawaii
2 2010, the legislature appropriated moneys from the emergency and
3 budget reserve fund to maintain levels of essential programs for
4 education, human services, health, and the public welfare. As
5 of December 2010, the new governor is in the process of
6 releasing the funds appropriated pursuant to Act 191. However,
7 due to the delay in the release of funds the expending agencies
8 may not have enough time to expend the funds before they lapse
9 at the end of the 2010-2011 fiscal year, thereby severely
10 curtailing their ability to help the persons recognized by the
11 legislature as being in dire need of these essential services.

12 The purpose of this Act is to extend to December 31, 2011
13 the date on which the funds will lapse to ensure the fulfillment
14 of the legislature's intent in passing Act 191, Session Laws of
15 Hawaii 2010.

16 SECTION 2. Act 191, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, is
17 amended as follows:



1 1. By amending section 12 to read:

2 "SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the emergency
3 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
4 \$332,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
6 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Waianae District Comprehensive
7 Health and Hospital Board, Incorporated to support its emergency
8 room services.

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
10 health for the purposes of this Act."

11 2. By amending section 16 to read:

12 "SECTION 16. There is appropriated out of the emergency
13 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
14 \$500,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
15 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
16 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Kokua Kalihi Valley Comprehensive
17 Family Services.

18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
19 health for the purposes of this Act."

20 3. By amending section 17 to read:

21 "SECTION 17. There is appropriated out of the emergency
22 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of



1 \$600,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
2 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Medical Service
4 Association for Keiki Care.

5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
6 human services for the purposes of this Act."

7 4. By amending section 18 to read:

8 "SECTION 18. There is appropriated out of the emergency
9 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
10 \$200,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
11 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
12 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Windward Oahu Spouse Abuse
13 Shelter.

14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
15 human services for the purposes of this Act."

16 5. By amending section 19 to read:

17 "SECTION 19. There is appropriated out of the emergency
18 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
19 \$200,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
20 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
21 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Blueprint for Change Program for
22 Neighborhood Place Walk-in Centers.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 human services for the purposes of this Act."

3 6. By amending section 21 to read:

4 "SECTION 21. There is appropriated out of the emergency
5 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
6 \$762,500 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
7 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
8 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to support domestic violence shelters
9 statewide[-] and to be distributed as follows:

10	(1) <u>Child and Family Service</u>	
11	(A) <u>Two shelters on Oahu</u>	<u>\$206,429</u>
12	(B) <u>Two shelters on Big Island</u>	<u>\$206,429</u>
13	(2) <u>Parents and Children Together</u>	<u>\$103,214</u>
14	(3) <u>Women Helping Women</u>	<u>\$103,214</u>
15	(4) <u>Hale Hoomalu</u>	<u>\$40,000</u>
16	(5) <u>Young Women's Christian</u>	
17	<u>Association of Kauai</u>	<u>\$103,214</u>

18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
19 human services for the purposes of this Act."

20 7. By amending section 22 to read:

21 "SECTION 22. There is appropriated out of the emergency
22 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of



1 \$210,000 for fiscal year 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants
2 pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Hale
3 Mahaolu for personal care services.

4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
5 human services for the purposes of this Act."

6 8. By amending section 30 to read:

7 "SECTION 30. There is appropriated out of the emergency
8 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
9 \$200,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
10 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
11 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Adult Friends for Youth for youth
12 gang prevention and intervention services.

13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
14 human services for the purposes of this Act."

15 9. By amending section 32 to read:

16 "SECTION 32. There is appropriated out of the emergency
17 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
18 \$200,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
19 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
20 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Volunteer Legal Services Hawaii to
21 provide pro bono legal services for indigent persons.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
2 the purposes of this Act."

3 10. By amending section 33 to read:

4 "SECTION 33. There is appropriated out of the emergency
5 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
6 \$720,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
7 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
8 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Legal Aid Society of Hawaii to
9 provide general civil legal services.

10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
11 the purposes of this Act."

12 11. By amending section 34 to read:

13 "SECTION 34. There is appropriated out of the emergency
14 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
15 \$282,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
16 2010-2011 for the University of Hawaii Family Law Clinic to
17 provide services to obtain temporary restraining orders.

18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
19 the purposes of this Act."

20 12. By amending section 35 to read:

21 "SECTION 35. There is appropriated out of the emergency
22 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of



1 \$150,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
2 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Catholic Charities Hawaii to provide
4 intra-familial sex assault services.

5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
6 the purposes of this Act."

7 13. By amending section 36 to read:

8 "SECTION 36. There is appropriated out of the emergency
9 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
10 \$150,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
11 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
12 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Children's Alliance of Hawaii,
13 Incorporated to provide child sex assault services.

14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
15 the purposes of this Act."

16 14. By amending section 38 to read:

17 "SECTION 38. There is appropriated out of the emergency
18 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
19 \$75,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
20 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
21 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the YMCA of Honolulu for the Weed
22 and Seed Program.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act."

3 15. By amending section 39 to read:

4 "SECTION 39. There is appropriated out of the emergency
5 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
6 \$466,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
7 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
8 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Kapiolani Medical Center for
9 Women and Children for the sex abuse treatment center for
10 statewide sex assault services.

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
12 the attorney general for the purposes of this Act."

13 16. By amending section 40 to read:

14 "SECTION 40. There is appropriated out of the emergency
15 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
16 \$300,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
17 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
18 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Families for R.E.A.L. program.

19 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
20 education for the purposes of this Act."

21 17. By amending section 41 to read:



1 "SECTION 41. This Act shall take effect on July 1,
2 2010 [-]; provided that the appropriations made by this Act shall
3 not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which the
4 appropriations are made; provided further that moneys from the
5 appropriations made by this Act that are unencumbered as of
6 December 31, 2011, shall lapse at the close of business on that
7 date."

8 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
9 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$60,000 or
10 so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 to
11 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii
12 Revised Statutes, to The Path Clinic for perinatal clinical and
13 social services for women in Hawaii with past or present
14 substance abuse.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
16 health for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
18 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$447,750
19 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011
20 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii
21 Revised Statutes, to Hawai'i Centers for Independent Living for
22 the statewide independent living purchase of services.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 human services for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 5. The appropriations made by sections 3 and 4 of
4 this Act shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which
5 the appropriations are made; provided that moneys from the
6 appropriations made by sections 3 and 4 of this Act that are
7 unencumbered as of December 31, 2011, shall lapse at the close
8 of business on that date.

9 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
