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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FLAGS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

- 1           SECTION 1. Chapter 421J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
3 and to read as follows:
- 4           "§421J-    Display of American flags. (a) An association  
5 shall allow the display of an American flag on all detached  
6 single-family residential units and on all single-story attached  
7 residential units subject to the following restrictions:
- 8           (1) Flags shall be no larger than four feet by six feet;  
9           (2) Flags shall be mounted on an exterior wall of the unit  
10           within five feet of the main entrance or garage door;  
11           (3) Mounting hardware shall be set at an angle of between  
12           thirty and eighty degrees;  
13           (4) The highest point of the mounting hardware shall be no  
14           higher than ten feet from ground level; and  
15           (5) Flags shall not be mounted on a free-standing flag  
16           pole; provided that an association may, by rule,  
17           authorize the display of flags on flag poles, subject  
18           to conditions and limitations.



1        (b) An association shall not charge a fee or require any  
2 approval process for the display of mounted flags pursuant to  
3 this section."

4        SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

5        SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
