
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "§26- Lieutenant governor special fund. (a) There is
5 established in the state treasury the lieutenant governor
6 special fund, into which shall be deposited all revenues from
7 name change fees, apostille and certification fees, and copy
8 fees.

9 (b) Moneys in the lieutenant governor special fund shall be
10 used for the administration and operation of the functions of
11 the lieutenant governor as provided in section 26-1(a)."

12 SECTION 2. Chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
13 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
14 read as follows:

15 "§92- Lieutenant governor; fees. The lieutenant
16 governor shall charge the following fees which shall be
17 deposited to the lieutenant governor special fund:

18 (1) For signing an apostille or certification, \$10;

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- 1 (2) For preparing every photostat copy of any
2 document on record in the lieutenant governor's
3 office, 50 cents per page or portion thereof; and
4 (3) For all other acts and duties, the fees of which
5 are not otherwise provided for, such charges as
6 the lieutenant governor may from time to time
7 prescribe."

8 SECTION 3. Section 91-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

10 "(a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, each agency
11 may charge up to a maximum fee of ten cents per page, plus the
12 actual costs of mailing, for the reproduction of paper copies of
13 the following:

- 14 (1) Proposed and final rules, whether new rules, amended
15 rules, or repealed rules, in any format; and
16 (2) Notices of proposed rulemaking actions pursuant to
17 section

18 This section shall not apply to the reproduction by the office
19 of the lieutenant governor of other agencies' rules, kept in the
20 general collection of the office of the lieutenant governor.

21 Charges for the reproduction of paper copies of rules in the

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1 general collection of the office of the lieutenant governor
2 shall be as stated in section [~~92-21~~] 92-_____."

3 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$80,000 or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012, to carry
6 out the purposes of this Act, including the hiring of necessary
7 staff. The sum appropriated shall be deposited into the
8 Lieutenant Governor Special Fund and shall expended by the
9 office of the lieutenant governor.

10 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the Lieutenant
11 Governor Special Fund the sum of \$80,000 or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 to carry out the
13 purposes of this Act, including the hiring of necessary staff.
14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of the
15 lieutenant governor.

16 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.

DEPARTMENT: Office of the Lieutenant Governor

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE

PURPOSE: Establishes the Lieutenant Governor special
fund in the lieutenant governor's office,
and provides that all revenue from name
changes, apostille and certification fees,
and copy fees be deposited into the fund.

MEANS: Adds news sections to chapters 26 and 92 and
amend section 91.2-5(a), Hawaii Revised
Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: The creation of the special fund will ensure
that the individuals that benefit from the
services provided to them by the lieutenant
governor's office will pay for the cost of
providing the service.

Impact on the public: The bill ensures that
the general public will not subsidize the
cost of providing services for name changes,
apostilles and certifications, or for copy
fees.

Impact on the department and other agencies:
There is no impact on other departments.
