
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRESIDENT BARACK OBAMA DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "§8- President Barack Obama Day. August fourth shall be
5 known and designated as "President Barack Obama Day." This day
6 shall not be construed to be a state holiday."

7 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
