
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2011-2012
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the tenth
6 representative district, as follows:

7 1. Princess Nahienaena elementary school

15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,805,000 or so much
 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 for a
 18 grant to the Lahainaluna High School Foundation for completion
 19 of the stadium renovation project at Lahainaluna high school in
 20 Lahaina, Maui, including lights, a track, a press box, and
 21 renovation of the former cafeteria building as follows:

4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
5 education for the purposes of this Act.

6 SECTION 3. The appropriations made for the capital
7 improvement projects authorized by section 2 of this Act shall
8 not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which the
9 appropriations are made; provided that all moneys from the
10 appropriations unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as
11 of that date.

12 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated for the respective
13 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
14 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act;
15 provided that:

- 16 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 5 shall be
17 expended by the department of education;
- 18 (2) The sums appropriated in items 6 and 7 shall be
19 expended by the department of transportation;
- 20 (3) The sum appropriated in item 8 shall be expended by
21 the department of human services; and



1 (4) The sum appropriated in item 9 shall be expended by
2 the department of land and natural resources.

3 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
