
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROSTITUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 712, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§712- Forfeiture of motor vehicle. The court may
5 forfeit, pursuant to chapter 712A, the motor vehicle of any
6 person convicted of an offense under this part; provided that
7 the court finds that the motor vehicle:

8 (1) Was used to commit, or facilitated commission of, the
9 offense for which the person was convicted; or

10 (2) Represents proceeds of the offense."

11 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
13 begun before its effective date.

14 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
