
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO DESIGNATE THE FACILITY
OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE LOCATED AT 330 SARATOGA
ROAD IN HONOLULU, HAWAII AS THE DON HO POST OFFICE
BUILDING.

1 WHEREAS, legendary Hawaiian entertainer Donald Tai Loy Ho,
2 more commonly known as Don Ho, passed away on April 14, 2007;
3 and

5 WHEREAS, known internationally, Don Ho was a headline
6 entertainer in Waikiki on the island of Oahu for more than
7 forty-three years and made numerous appearances in film and
8 television; and

10 WHEREAS, after athletic success in high school and college,
11 Don Ho joined the Air Force and became a fighter pilot, flying
12 transport planes between Hickam Air Force Base in Hawaii and
13 Tokyo; and

15 WHEREAS, in 2001, Don Ho was the first Hawaiian artist to
16 receive a Record Industry Association of America-certified
17 "gold" record for sales of more than 500,000 copies of his
18 album, Don Ho's Greatest Hits; and

20 WHEREAS, in 2006, the City and County of Honolulu honored
21 him with a proclamation for his contributions to the State's
22 music industry and named him one of the major contributors to
23 Hawaii's tourism industry; now, therefore,

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
26 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
27 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that in recognition of the
28 contributions made by Don Ho to the people of Hawaii and the

1 world, the United States Congress is respectfully requested to
 2 designate the facility of the United States Postal Service
 3 located at 330 Saratoga Road in Honolulu, Hawaii, as the "Don Ho
 4 Post Office Building"; and

 6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the United States Congress is
 7 requested to provide that any reference in a law, map,
 8 regulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
 9 States to the facility of the United States Postal Service at
 10 330 Saratoga Road in Honolulu, Hawaii shall be deemed to be a
 11 reference to the "Don Ho Post Office Building"; and

 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 14 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the
 15 United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of
 16 Representatives, members of Hawaii's congressional delegation,
 17 the United States Postmaster General, the Chairperson of the
 18 Board of Directors of the United States Postal Service, the
 19 United States Postmaster of the facility of the United States
 20 Postal Service located at 330 Saratoga Road, Honolulu, Hawaii,
 21 and Mr. Dwight Ho, who in turn is requested to transmit copies
 22 to other members of the family of the late Don Ho.
