HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE GOVERNOR OF HAWAI'I TO INVITE ALL APEC COUNTRIES TO ESTABLISH HONORARY CONSULS IN HAWAI'I AHEAD OF THE 2011 APEC SUMMIT.

WHEREAS, the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation, or APEC, is 1 2 a forum of twenty-one Pacific Rim countries established in 1989 to promote free trade and economic co-operation throughout the 3 Asia-Pacific region; and 4 5 WHEREAS, from November 12-13, APEC will convene its 23rd 6 annual summit in Honolulu, Hawai'i; and 7 8 WHEREAS, there will be heads of state and officials from 9 the twenty-one member countries but, Hawai'i has just 4 honorary 10 consuls from those member countries; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the role of the honorary consul is to undertake 13 and safeguard the interests of the sending country as well as to 14 further the development of commercial, economic, cultural and 15 scientific relations between the sending state and the host 16 state; and 17 18 WHEREAS, the honorary consul would help expedite the 19 20 processing of visas and provide communications between diplomats and Washington D.C.; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, the APEC conference can potentially result in the establishment of economic trade relations between the state of 24 Hawai'i and member countries; and 25 26 WHEREAS, having honorary consuls can be instrumental in the 27 retaining of and fostering the growth of such relations; now, 28 . 29 therefore, 30




