
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES TO IDENTIFY AND PRIORITIZE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE PROJECTS FOR ALL STATE BUILDINGS BASED ON HEALTH AND SAFETY NEEDS.

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Accounting and General Services
2 oversees the planning, coordination, and organization of
3 building maintenance, and controls a variety of engineering and
4 architectural services for the State; and

6 WHEREAS, these services include land acquisition, planning,
7 designing, inspecting, and managing construction projects,
8 facilitating quality control, contracting, and equipping
9 facilities and other improvements for State agencies; and

11 WHEREAS, every year the Legislature proposes capital
12 improvement projects to address the critical needs of state
13 facilities; and

15 WHEREAS, prioritizing projects by health and safety needs
16 will give the Legislature the opportunity to ensure that funds
17 will be allocated to the facilities with the greatest need; now,
18 therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
21 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
22 of 2011, that the Department of Accounting and General Services
23 is requested to identify and prioritize repair and maintenance
24 projects for all state buildings based on health and safety
25 needs; and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Accounting
28 and General Services is requested to report its findings and
29 recommendations to the Legislature no later than 60 days prior
30 to the convening of the Regular Session of 2012; and
