
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE BUDGET.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
2 to the department of Hawaiian home lands.

3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,500,000 or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 and the
6 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
7 2012-2013 for the department of Hawaiian home lands to
8 effectively assess and track programmatic needs of applicants on
9 its waitlists in order to determine the amount of future
10 appropriations required by the department for the following
11 purposes:

- 12 (1) Development of home, agriculture, farm, and ranch
13 lots;
- 14 (2) Home, agriculture, aquaculture, farm and ranch loans;
- 15 (3) Rehabilitation projects that include, but are not
16 limited to, educational, economic, political, social,
17 and cultural processes that improve the general
18 welfare and conditions of native Hawaiians; and

1 (4) The administration and operating budget of the
2 department of Hawaiian home lands.

3 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the
4 department of Hawaiian home lands for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
