Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 129
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PERINATAL CARE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to reduce substance abuse among
pregnant women by appropriating \$200,000 in each year of the 2011-
2013 fiscal biennium for the Perinatal Addiction Treatment of
Hawaii Clinic for case management and other social services.

Healthy Mothers Healthy Babies Coalition of Hawaii, the March
of Dimes Foundation Hawaii Chapter, the League of Women Voters
Hawaii, Planned Parenthood of Hawaii, the Hawaii State Democratic
Women's Caucus, the Drug Policy Forum of Hawaii, the Women's
Coalition, and many concerned individuals testified in support of
this bill. The Department of Health supported the intent of this
measure.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:


- (1) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2050, to
facilitate further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,
consistency, and style.
