Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.B. No. 1325 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to provide increased financial flexibility to the University of Hawaii (UH) by authorizing UH to retain up to five percent of general funds appropriated, with certain exceptions, to be carried over to the subsequent fiscal year.

UH supported this measure.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- (1) Including reporting requirements similar to those required of the Department of Education for the carryover of funds; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 1325, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second
