Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 1330
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOBACCO SETTLEMENT
SPECIAL FUND,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to extend the authorization that
allocates a portion of Hawaii Tobacco Settlement Special Fund
moneys to the John A. Burns School of Medicine for annual
operating expenses.

The University of Hawaii System, the Healthcare Association
of Hawaii, Hawaii Pacific Health, the Hawaii Medical Service
Association, the Hawaii Primary Care Association, Kalihi-Palama
Health Center, The Chamber of Commerce of Hawaii, The Queen's
Health Systems, and numerous concerned individuals testified in
support of this bill. The Hawaii COPD Coalition and Coalition for
a Tobacco-Free Hawaii opposed this measure. The Department of
Health, American Cancer Society, and American Heart Association
provided comments.


Your Committee has amended this bill by changing its
effective date to July 1, 2050, to encourage further discussion.
Technical, nonsubstantive amendments were also made for clarity,
consistency, and style.
