Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred  
H.B. No. 1442 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO FISHING,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to assist the fishing industry on  
the Island of Hawaii by requiring the Pacific Aquaculture and  
Coastal Resources Center at the University of Hawaii at Hilo (UH  
Hilo) to conduct a study on the feasibility of developing a public  
entity on the Island of Hawaii modeled after the commercial  
fishing village at the City and County of Honolulu's Pier 38.

A concerned individual supported this bill with amendments.  
UH Hilo supported the intent of this measure.

Your Committee has amended this by:

- (1) Clarifying language in the purpose section to specify  
the nature of the pier and commercial fishing village;  
and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,  
consistency, and style.
