Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 931
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SMALL BOAT HARBORS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to clarify the purpose and use of
the State's small boat harbors by adding a definition for
"regularly navigated" under Chapter 200, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
Ocean Recreation and Coastal Areas Programs, to require vessels
that are moored within small boat harbors or in offshore mooring
areas to be moved under their own power at least once per ninety
days.


The Department of Land and Natural Resources, Ocean Tourism
