Your Committee on Judiciary, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 198 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE JUDICIARY TO EXPEDITE THE SELECTION OF THE SITE FOR THE KONA JUDICIARY COMPLEX AND CONSIDER LA'I'OPUA AS A POTENTIAL SITE FOR THE COMPLEX,"
