Your Committee on Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred
H.C.R. No. 293 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION EXPRESSING LEGISLATIVE SUPPORT
FOR AND REQUESTING THE REMOVAL OF THE TERM "TREATY OF
ANNEXATION" CAST IN BRONZE ON THE STATUE OF PRESIDENT
MCKINLEY ON THE GROUNDS OF MCKINLEY HIGH SCHOOL,"


begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to correct
misinformation about the history of Hawaii by expressing
legislative support for and requesting the removal of the term
"Treaty of Annexation" cast in bronze on the statue of President
McKinley on the grounds of McKinley High School. The so-called
"Treaty of Annexation" never existed and was never implemented.
President McKinley signed a joint resolution of annexation on July
7, 1898, that was passed by the United States House of
Representatives and the United States Senate, purporting to annex
the Hawaiian Islands as a war necessity.

The Office of Hawaiian Affairs, Association of Hawaiian Civic
Clubs, I Love Kalihi Valley, Ka Lei Maile Alii Hawaiian Civic
Club, Kosmos Indigena, Sovereign Councils of the Hawaiian
Homelands Assembly, The Hawaiian Kingdom, and many concerned
individuals supported this measure. Several concerned individuals
opposed this measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Hawaiian Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 293 and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Education.


