Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred
H.C.R. No. 45 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY RELATING TO
SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS ON ROOSEVELT BRIDGE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to address
safety concerns on Roosevelt Bridge.

The Department of Transportation (DOT) testified in
opposition to the resolution.


Roosevelt Bridge, which spans Kipapa Gulch, was built in
1933, is narrow with limited visibility, and has been the sight of
numerous fatal accidents and serious injuries. Flooding has caused
the bridge to close on a number of occasions. The DOT opposed the
measure because they are already conducting an environmental
assessment for the Kamehameha Highway Improvements, which includes
the Roosevelt Bridge, and a feasibility study would be redundant.
The assessment is considering two alternatives related to
Roosevelt Bridge and the DOT expects to publish the draft
environmental assessment in December 2011.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Transportation that is attached to this report, your
Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 45 and
recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Finance.
