Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.R. No. 248
entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE STATE AND THE CITY AND
COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO SUPPORT A WASTE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM THAT
EQUITABLY DISTRIBUTES ITS BENEFITS AND BURDENS ACROSS THE
COMMUNITY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this resolution is to address the fact that
the Leeward coast of Oahu shoulders a disproportionate share of
the island's waste by urging the State and City and County of
Honolulu to support a waste management system that equitably
distributes its benefits and burdens across the community.

The City and County of Honolulu Department of Environmental
Services, PVT Land Company, and the General Contractors
Association of Hawaii opposed this measure. The Resort Group and
Iron Workers Local commented on this measure.

Your Committee has amended this resolution by:

- (1) Removing references to specific landfills;
- (2) Deleting provisions relating to fees; and

- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.
