Your Committee on Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred  
S.B. No. 2, S.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE PUBLIC LAND,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to more accurately and  
efficiently manage public land trust lands in accordance with the  
requirements of the Hawaii State Constitution and the Admission  
Act by requiring the Department of Land and Natural Resources  
(DLNR) to initiate and coordinate all efforts to establish a  
public land trust information system, including, among other  
things, a determination of the type of information about each  
parcel of land to be included.

This measure also appropriates an unspecified amount for the  
establishment and maintenance of a computerized, comprehensive  
statewide public land trust inventory database.

Papa Ola Lokahi and the Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs  
supported this bill. DLNR, the Department of the Attorney  
General, and Office of Hawaiian Affairs offered comments.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Hawaiian Affairs that is attached to this report,  
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B.
