Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 333, S.D. 3, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to expand the uses of the Hawaii Historic Preservation Special Fund and to capitalize on accelerated construction programming proposed by the new administration to assist in the restoration and preservation of such heritage assets as the Bernice Pauahi Bishop Museum, Iolani Palace, Washington Place, and Mauna Ala.

The Department of Land and Natural Resources, Historic Hawaii Foundation, Bishop Museum, Maunaloa Hawaiian Civic Club, Aha Kiole Advisory Committee, Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs, Hawaii Maoli, and a concerned individual supported this bill. The Department of Budget and Finance and Department of Accounting and General Services offered comments.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:


- (1) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2030 to encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.
