Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 45
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to provide a more effective
administrative and operational management of the Sheriff Division
by repealing the civil service exemptions for the first and second
deputy sheriffs. This bill is also in line with legislation aimed
at reducing the number of civil service exempt employees in public
service within the State.

The Department of Public Safety and several concerned
individuals supported this measure.


Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- (1) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2030, to promote

- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,
consistency, and style.
