Your Committee on Public Safety, Government Operations, and
Military Affairs, to which was referred S.B. No. 879 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO UNIFORM MAINTENANCE
ALLOWANCE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to repeal the
uniform maintenance allowance for enlisted personnel on July 1,
2112.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from one state department. Testimony in opposition to this
measure was received from one individual.

According to testimony of the State Department of Defense,
this measure would allow monies that were earmarked for uniform
maintenance to be reallocated to the Hawaii National Guard Tuition
Assistance Program. This program awards tuition assistance to
qualified, enlisted warrant officers, and officers up to the rank
of Captain who are state residents and undergraduate students
working toward a degree on any campus in Hawaii.

Your Committee has amended this measure by making technical,
nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and
consistency.


As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
