Hawaiians and native Hawaiians by appropriating funds for the
operating budget of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA).

OHA, the Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs, Papa Ola
Lokahi, Aha Kiolo Advisory Committee, and the Sovereign Councils
of the Hawaiian Homelands Assembly testified in support of this
bill.


Your Committee has amended this bill by changing its
effective date to July 1, 2011.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Hawaiian Affairs that is attached to this report,
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B.
No. 985, S.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass
Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 985, S.D.
1, H.D. 1, and be referred to the Committee on Finance.
