The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to support the
Community Services Block Grant Program and oppose cutting the
budget to this program by fifty percent as proposed by the United

Inc (HCAP), Catholic Charities Hawaii, and Kauai Economic
Opportunity, Inc. (KEO) submitted testimony in support of this
