
<u>HB 289</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Requires an agricultural subdivision or agricultural condominium in an agricultural district to be approved by the relevant county council by ordinance.	AGR/WLO, JUD
<u>HB 1230</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO BUILDING PERMITS. Exempts from county building permit requirements construction of low risk nonresidential and aquacultural structures, under certain conditions.	AGR/WLO, JUD
<u>HB 226</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO LANDOWNER LIABILITY. Establishes that an owner or possessor of private land that is closed to the public owes no duty of care to a person who commits the offense of criminal trespass on the owner's or occupier's land, except where death or injury to the trespasser may result from the owner's or occupier's gross negligence or wilful conduct; clarifies that provisions related to criminal trespass in the second degree apply to agricultural lands that are fallow. 
