SB154 Testimony Status	RELATING TO BROKER PRICE OPINIONS. Permits a licensed real estate broker or real estate sales person to prepare broker price options for use in real estate transactions where an appraisal is not required by law or otherwise.	CPN
SB646 Testimony Status	RELATING TO ESCROW DEPOSITORIES. Requires every person subject to section 454F-1.5 to include the person's unique identifier on every document submitted to an escrow depository in a real estate transaction; requires escrow depositories to report invalid unique identifiers to the commissioner of financial institutions.	CPN
SB750 Testimony Status	RELATING TO CONDOMINIUMS. Permits members of condominium associations to make electronic recordings of association meetings for personal use.	CPN
