DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

SB1086 Testimony Status	RELATING TO CONSUMER INFORMATION. Requires bread products that have been baked and then frozen to be labeled "previously frozen". Prohibits bread that has been frozen to be labeled or advertised as "fresh".	CPN
SB597 SD1 (SSCR425) Testimony Status	RELATING TO PSYCHOLOGISTS. Authorizes limited prescriptive authority for qualified psychologists who practice at a federally qualified health center. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)	HTH, CPN
SB1161 SD1 (SSCR288) Testimony Status	RELATING TO TELECOMMUNICATIONS. Exempts broadband infrastructure improvements from state or county permitting requirements for five years. Exempts telecommunications companies from replacing existing utility poles when installing new or improving existing telecommunications cables. Takes effect 7/1/2050. (SD1)	EDT/PGM, CPN
