HB1411 HD2 (HSCR917) Testimony Status	RELATING TO MORTGAGE FORECLOSURES. Repeals the old non-judicial foreclosure process. Clarifies the new non-judicial foreclosure process. Strengthens laws regarding mortgage servicers. Broadens the duties of the Center for Alternative Dispute Resolution. Effective July 1, 2050. (HB1411 HD2)	CPN, WAM
HB879 HD1 (HSCR726) Testimony Status	RELATING TO MORTGAGE FORECLOSURES. Implements recommendations of the mortgage foreclosure task force relating to service of notice, conversion from nonjudicial to judicial foreclosure, bar against deficiency judgments, notice of pendency of action, and extinguishment of a mortgagor's interest. Effective July 1, 2030. (HB879 HD1)	CPN, WAM
HB1221 HD1 (HSCR632) Testimony Status	<u>RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.</u> <u>Exempts liquor licensees from certain violations when licensees have a security plan approved by the liquor commission to prevent minors from consuming alcohol on the licensee's premises and the licensee acts in good faith in implementing that plan. Defines large public facility.</u> Effective January 7, 2059. (HB1221 HD1)	<u>PGM/CPN, JDL</u> [Measure added on 3/22/2011]
