<u>HB 338</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Requires the members of the board of education to be nominated and, with the advice and consent of the senate, appointed by the governor from lists of qualified candidates presented to the governor by the board of education selection advisory council.	EDN, FIN
<u>HB 908</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Provides that the single school calendar for all public schools does not apply to schools designated by BOE in furtherance of a plan to improve educational outcome in students.	EDN, FIN
<u>HB 951</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO SCHOOL REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE. Appropriates moneys to the Hawaii 3R's as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes.	EDN, FIN
<u>HB 1054</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Amends Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to require the Committee on Weights to meet not less than once every odd-numbered year	EDN, FIN



<u>HB 1055</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Repeal the administration of nationally normed reference test.	EDN, FIN
<u>HB 1058</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO CAPITAL INVESTMENTS. Amends chapter 37, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to include agency-wide technology and computer systems with an estimated useful life of greater than seven years as capital investments to allow all costs to be financed with bond funds and depreciated as capital investments.	EDN, FIN
<u>HB 953</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Repeals the BOE's authority to set the salaries of the deputy superintendent, assistant superintendents, and complex area superintendents, and the cap on those salaries.	EDN/LAB, FIN
<u>HB 1056</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE CERTIFICATION OF PRINCIPALS AND VICE-PRINCIPALS. Amends section 302A-605, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to replace language regarding principal and vice-principal candidate qualifications that conflicts with the requirements of the Race to the Top grant.	EDN/LAB, FIN
<u>HB 1540</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Makes permanent statutory provisions that: (1) reduced the maximum employment period for teachers hired on an emergency basis by DOE from 4 years to 3 years; and (2) require those unlicensed teachers hired on an emergency basis prior to 7/1/08, to attain licensure within 4 years from the date of employment.	EDN/LAB, FIN

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
