<u>SB 1287</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY. Specifies a funding amount for the Shared Services Special Fund, establishes a Trust Fund, removes CIO oversight of the information and communication division, and adds a sunset date.	EDT, WAM
<u>SB 1285</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO CAPITAL INVESTMENTS. Amends chapter 37, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to include agency-wide technology and computer systems with an estimated useful life of greater than seven years as capital investments to allow all costs to be financed with bond funds and depreciated as capital investments.	EDT, WAM
<u>SB 237</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO CYBERBULLYING. Establishes an offense of harassment by cyberbullying, with the first and second offenses as misdemeanors, and any third and subsequent offense as a class C felony.	EDT, JDL
<u>SB 1207</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO TRESPASS. Holds authors and publishers of visitor websites and publications liable to readers who suffer injury or death as a result of being enticed to trespass; exempts property owners from liability.	EDT, JDL
<u>SB 1498</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	<u>RELATING TO THE SMALL BUSINESS REGULATORY REVIEW BOARD.</u> <u>Requires the Small Business Regulatory Review Board to identify rules that shall be amended or repealed to conform to the repeal or amendment of related statutes. Directs the board to work with state agencies to develop a procedure for expediting the amendment or repeal of rules when the changes are required only to comply with the repeal or amendment of statutes.</u>	EDT <u>[Measure added on 02-03-11]</u>
