<u>SB 807</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS. Clarifies that charter schools that have their charter revoked or reauthorization denied may appeal to the board of education for a final decision; prohibits a relative of a designated head of a school or employee of a school from serving as the chair of the local school board; requires charter schools and their local school boards to develop internal policies and procedures consistent with ethical standards of conduct, pursuant to chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes. <u>SB 1174</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS. Establishes a funding formula for charter school facilities.	EDU, WAM

When faxing, please indicate to which committee the testimony is being submitted and the date and time of the hearing.

Please note: If you submit your written testimony after 4:00 p.m. the day prior to the hearing, please sign-in at the staff table to testify orally. A copy of your testimony may not be available during the hearing but will be posted online for the public after the hearing.
