Status

~~Requires the Department of Agriculture (DOA) to publish an annual report on pesticide use in the State including investigations of health complaints by the Department of Health. Requires users of pesticides to report usage to DOA. Permits DOA to impose a fee to recover costs.~~

HB 470

Status

RELATING TO TAXATION.

Requires a marine terminal operator, rather than a distributor, to collect the tax from the owner of petroleum products at the time those products are received at the terminal. Repeals the sunset date of Act 73, SLH 2010.

HB 1386
Status

RELATING TO FUEL TAXES.
Raises the environmental response, energy, and food security tax and distributes revenues from the increase in the tax to the energy security special fund and the agricultural development and food security special fund.

RELATING TO SUSTAINABILITY.
Authorizes the revision of allocation from the Environmental Response, Energy, and Food Security Tax. Effective 07/01/11.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

WEB: For comments less than 4MB in size, transmit from the Web page at <http://www.capitol.hawaii.gov/emailtestimony>.


Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
