<u>HB 266</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO WATER QUALITY STANDARDS. Repeals the sunset date of 06/30/11 for Act 126, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, relating to revisions of certain state water quality standards.	EEP/WLO
<u>HB 122</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY. Extends the repeal date of Act 173 (2009), which exempts renewable energy projects from subdivision requirements on State agricultural or conservation lands.	EEP/WLO, AGR
<u>HB 424</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENTS. Extends the sunset date for EIS exceptions for secondary actions from July 1, 2011, to July 1, 2013.	EEP/WLO, FIN


