Requires diesel fuel sold in the State for use in motor vehicles to contain no less than 5% biodiesel that is produced in the State from agricultural products grown in the State. (HD1 PROPOSED)

RELATING TO LIGHT POLLUTION.

TRN, EEP, FIN

Requires every new and replacement outdoor light fixtures to be fully shielded beginning on July 1, 2013, with certain exemptions. Defines fully shielded. Effective July 1, 2011. (SB1493 HD1)
