SB 1425 RELATING TO SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT. ENE/PGM, WAM

Prohibits landfills in counties with populations greater than 500,000 from accepting municipal solid waste, beginning 7/1/12. Prohibits landfills in counties with populations less than 500,000 from accepting

municipal solid waste after a date determined by council resolution.
