Status

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.
Proposed HD1: Authorizes peer-to-peer games of skill, including poker, in which each player receives the player's personal winnings from the game but in which no other person or entity derives any proceeds based on the outcome of the game. Permits licensed venue to charge fee to participate in game or percentage of total wagers in game, or both. Authorizes issuance of not more than two licenses to operate infrastructure for online peer-to-peer games of skill for a minimum fee of \$100 million per year, 20% of total wagers, and advertising for State. Prohibits licensee from participating, directly or indirectly in games and prohibits participation by computer. Establishes Peer-to-Peer Gaming Commission. Effective 7/1/2012.




