RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW.

LAB/ERB, FIN

Provides for payment of interest due on Title XII loans from the Employment and Training Fund. Authorizes the Director of Labor and Industrial Relations to increase the Employment and Training Fund assessment in increments of .01 per cent retroactive to January 1, 2011.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
