Status

RELATING TO SOLID WASTE.

EEP, FIN

Applies the solid waste disposal surcharge to waste that is deposited in landfills, incinerators, or waste-to-energy facilities, whether the waste

is disposed of in-state or transferred out-of-state.

HB 1017, HD1

RELATING TO BIOFUELS.

EEP, FIN

Modifies the renewable energy facility siting process to include biofuel (HSCR206) production facilities and distribution infrastructure with capacity to <u>Status</u> produce or distribute one hundred thousand gallons or more of biofuel

annually.

HB 1019 (HSCR352)

Status

RELATING TO SUSTAINABILITY.

EEP/AGR, FIN

Authorizes the revision of allocation from the Environmental Response, Energy, and Food Security Tax. Effective 07/01/11.

HB 927 (HSCR136) Status

RELATING TO ROADWAY MATERIALS.

EEP, FIN

EEP/WLO, FIN

Clarifies that state agencies may purchase roadway materials with a minimum recycled glass content. Allows use of minimum glass of ten

per cent crushed glass aggregate in all basecourse and subbase.

HB 424 (HSCR109) **Status**

RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENTS. Extends the sunset date for EIS exceptions for secondary actions from

July 1, 2011, to July 1, 2013.

RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY TRANSMISSION

CABLE.

Establishes the regulatory structure under which inter-island undersea energy transmission cables could be commercially developed,

financed, and constructed. Effective July 1, 2011.
