<u>HB 828, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR377)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO TAXATION. Establishes conditions to inspect required records and receipts of cash business transaction and permits records to be prepared by hand or by cash register. Clarifies state of mind for violation of record and receipt requirements. Limits fine for violation if person is otherwise in compliance with tax laws. Effective January 7, 2059.	JUD, FIN
<u>HB 1333</u> <u>(HSCR309)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO SMALL CLAIMS COURT. Increases the monetary limit of claims that may be filed in small claims court.	JUD, FIN
<u>HB 1139</u> <u>(HSCR308)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO DISTRICT COURTS. Clarifies the circumstances under which a district court may serve a summons or other writ outside of the State.	JUD, FIN
<u>HB 1004</u> <u>(HSCR376)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO CHAPTER 480, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES. entities to bring an action for damages notwithstanding their status as indirect purchasers.	JUD, FIN



HB 301
(HSCR306)
Status

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY COMPUTER SYSTEM SPECIAL FUND. JUD, FIN
Directs into the JCSSF fees collected for electronic document certification, electronic copies of documents, and for providing bulk access to electronic court records and compilations of data.

HB 549. HD1
(HSCR251)
Status

RELATING TO PUBLIC AGENCY MEETINGS. JUD, FIN
Requires notice of state and county board meetings to be posted on the appropriate internet website, and eliminates the requirement that notice be filed in the Office of the Lieutenant Governor. Effective January 7, 2050.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

PAPER: 2 copies to Room 306 in the State Capitol;



Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
