<u>SB 823, SD1, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1161)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Provides procurement authority to semi-autonomous county public transit agencies, thus allowing them to function as semi-autonomous agencies in their respective counties. Effective July 1, 2011.	TRN/ERB, FIN
<u>SB 1324, SD2, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1110)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO RENTAL MOTOR VEHICLE SURCHARGE TAX. Adjusts the rental motor vehicle surcharge tax. Makes appropriation from the state highway fund. Effective July 1, 2011.	TRN, FIN
<u>SB 1328, SD1, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1111)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION. Increases the State motor vehicle registration fee from \$25 to \$45 and deposits the money into the State Highway Fund. Effective December 1, 2011.	TRN, FIN
<u>SB 1329, SD1, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1164)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE WEIGHT TAX. Allows for increase in the State motor vehicle weight tax and deposits the money into the State Highway Fund. Effective December 1, 2011.	TRN, FIN
<u>SB 1327, SD2, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1163)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PASSENGER FACILITY CHARGES. Authorizes the Department of Transportation to collect increases in passenger facility charges without amending the administrative rules. Effective July 1, 2011.	TRN, FIN

Status

RELATING TO THE ALOHA TOWER DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

TRN/WLO, FIN

Abolishes the Aloha Tower Development Corporation (ATDC). Transfers the ATDC assets to the Hawaii Community Development Authority (HCDA). Establishes the Aloha Tower Complex under the jurisdiction of HCDA. Makes an appropriation. Effective July 1, 2011.

Status

RELATING TO WATER CARRIERS.

TRN/CPC, FIN

Requires public hearings subject to specified notice requirements before PUC approval of a water carrier's certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN); specifies required findings for a CPCN; requires posting of documents on PUC's website.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least 24 hours prior to the hearing with a transmittal cover indicating:

- Testifier's name with position/title and organization;
- The Committee the comments are directed to;
- The date and time of the hearing;
- Measure number; and
- The number of copies the Committee is requesting.

While every effort will be made to copy, organize, and collate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed to the incorrect office, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.

Submit testimony in **ONE** of the following ways:

PAPER: 2 copies to Room 306 in the State Capitol;


FAX: For comments less than 5 pages in length, transmit to 586-6001 (Oahu) or 1-800-535-3859 (for Neighbor Islanders without a computer to submit testimony through e-mail or the Web); or

WEB: For comments less than 4MB in size, transmit from the Web page at <http://www.capitol.hawaii.gov/emailtestimony>.

Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
