Establishes a pilot program within the Department of Public Safety that assigns select, non-violent inmates on a work detail that restores historical sites selected by the Office of Hawaiian Affairs. Appropriates funds. (HB313 HD1)	PBM, HAW, FIN
<u>HB 377</u> <u>(HSCR203)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS. Provides state lease preferences to developers of Hawaiian fishponds.	WLO, HAW, FIN
<u>HB 378, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR168)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO LANDSCAPING OF PUBLIC FACILITIES. Requires, where feasible, the usage of native Hawaiian land plants for the landscaping of public buildings. (HB378 HD1)	ERB/AGR, HAW, FIN
<u>HB 402</u> <u>(HSCR67)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENTS. Requires all environmental assessments and environmental impact statements to include a cultural impact assessment. Requires OHA's approval of cultural impact assessments.	EPP, HAW/CUA, FIN

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DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least 24 hours prior to the hearing with a transmittal cover indicating:

- Testifier's name with position/title and organization;
- The Committee the comments are directed to;
- The date and time of the hearing;
- Measure number; and
- The number of copies the Committee is requesting.

While every effort will be made to copy, organize, and collate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed to the incorrect office, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.

Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:

PAPER: 1 copies (including an original) to Room 313 in the State Capitol;

WEB: For comments less than 4MB in size, transmit from the Web page at <http://www.capitol.hawaii.gov/emailtestimony>.

Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
