RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

HSG/HUS, FIN

PROPOSED HD1: Appropriates funds to designate existing parks or open or vacant space as a safe haven for persons who are homeless. Effective on July 1, 2011. (SB900 HD1)

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least 24 hours prior to the hearing with a transmittal cover indicating:

- Testifier's name with position/title and organization;
- The Committee the comments are directed to;
- The date and time of the hearing;
- Measure number; and
- The number of copies the Committee is requesting.


