Creates an advisory board charged with the duty of developing methodologies to enhance medical error reporting. Establishes the patient safety trust fund.</u>	HTH [Measure added on 2/4/2011]
<a href="#">SB1516</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a> <a href="#">Status</a>	RELATING TO HEALTH CARE ADMINISTRATIVE UNIFORMITY. <u>Exempts collaboration among managed care plans, health care providers, and government agencies from state antitrust laws when the collaboration is intended to adopt uniform administrative procedures.</u>	HTH, CPN [Measure added on 2/4/2011]
<a href="#">SB1507</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a> <a href="#">Status</a>	RELATING TO ACUPUNCTURE. <u>Authorizes the Hawaii medical board to regulate the practice of acupuncture by its licensees; repeals the authority of the board of acupuncture to regulate the practice of acupuncture by physicians, osteopathic physicians, and physician's assistants.</u>	HTH, CPN [Measure added on 2/4/2011]



<a href="#">SB1458</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a> <a href="#">Status</a>	<u>RELATING TO HEALTH.</u> <u>Creates three classes of medical marijuana licenses: class 1 medical marijuana compassion center license for the sale of medical marijuana to qualified patients; class 2 medical marijuana cultivation license; class 3 medical marijuana-infused products manufacturing license. Specifies requirements for each class. Makes medical marijuana sales subject to income and excise taxes. Establishes a special marijuana sales tax on sales of medical marijuana. Establishes a fee for issuance and renewal of a license and a special marijuana sales tax. Takes effect 8/7/2012.</u>	<u>HTH/PGM, WAM</u> [Measure added on 2/4/2011]

<a href="#">SB239</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a> <a href="#">Status</a>	<del><u>RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOBACCO SETTLEMENT SPECIAL FUND.</u></del> <del><u>Extends the appropriation of a portion of Hawaii tobacco settlement special fund moneys for annual operating expenses of JABSOM until June 30, 2015, and adds annual reporting requirements.</u></del>	<del><u>EDU/HTH, WAM</u></del> [Measure added on 2/4/2011] [Measure deleted on 2/8/2011]
<a href="#">SB240</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a> <a href="#">Status</a>	<del><u>RELATING TO PHYSICIAN WORKFORCE ASSESSMENT.</u></del> <del><u>Makes permanent the physician workforce assessment fee and requires that a portion of the assessment fees deposited into the John A. Burns school of medicine special fund be used to support physician workforce assessment and planning for rural and medically underserved areas of the State.</u></del>	<del><u>EDU/HTH, WAM</u></del> [Measure added on 2/4/2011] [Measure deleted on 2/8/2011]
<a href="#">SB922</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a> <a href="#">Status</a>	<del><u>RELATING TO HEALTH.</u></del> <del><u>Specifies additional elements of Hawaii's existing sexuality health education law and its implementation. Requires the department of education (DOE) to provide certain types of information to the public and to parents. Allows parents to opt out of the DOE's sexuality health education.</u></del>	<del><u>EDU/HTH</u></del> [Measure added on 2/4/2011] [Measure deleted on 2/8/2011]
