<a href="#">SB767</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a> <a href="#">Status</a>	RELATING TO ECONOMIC RECOVERY. Granting temporary relief from county housing requirements as recommended by the construction industry task force to stimulate housing construction statewide.	PGM/WLH
<a href="#">SB248</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a> <a href="#">Status</a>	RELATING TO FEES. Prohibits the imposition of impact fees in urban land use districts. Requires the department of transportation to charge nominal fees, based on appraised values, for the disposal of easements within and access rights along the state highway rights-of-way to be used for the installation of infrastructure in roadways.	WLH/PGM, WAM
<a href="#">SB638</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a> <a href="#">Status</a>	RELATING TO ZONING. Authorizes an exemption from county zoning-related building restrictions for an increase in floor area of the principal office of a planned community association, subject to conditions.	WLH/PGM, CPN
<a href="#">SB1556</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a> <a href="#">Status</a>	RELATING TO RAIL TRANSIT STATION DEVELOPMENT. Exempts developments within a half-mile radius of rail transit stations undertaken by qualified developers from generally applicable requirements.	WLH/PGM, JDL
