**WLH SB 683** RELATING TO KAKAAKO.

Allows the conveyance of transferable development rights from **Testimony** landowners in Kakaako makai to landowners in Kakaako mauka, **Status** subject to approval by the Hawaii community development authority.

Requires the Hawaii community development authority to adopt rules

to regulate and authorize these conveyances.

SB 897, SD1 RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS. HMS, WLH

Requires the Hawaii housing finance and development corporation, the (SSCR219) homeless programs office of the department of human services, and the Hawaii Association of Realtors to identify state-owned, state-managed, **Testimony** and other government and privately-owned or managed vacant housing **Status** units that could be used as affordable rental housing. Report annually

> to the governor and legislature; provided that if any act passed by the 2011 legislature establishes an interagency council on homelessness,

the report shall also be submitted annually to that council. (SD1)

RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS. PGM/EDU, WLH SB 1215, SD1

Creates a task force under the University of Hawaii Kapiolani (SSCR167) community college to conduct a study of the feasibility of transferring the lands currently under the jurisdiction of the department of land and **Testimony** 

> natural resources to the University of Hawaii Kapiolani community college for a legacy center for the 100th Infantry Battalion/442nd

Regimental Combat Team. Report to legislature. (SD1)
