Status</p> | <p>RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.
Requires the Hawaii housing finance and development corporation, the homeless programs office of the department of human services, and the Hawaii Association of Realtors to identify state-owned, state-managed, and other government and privately-owned or managed vacant housing units that could be used as affordable rental housing. Report annually to the governor and legislature; provided that if any act passed by the 2011 legislature establishes an interagency council on homelessness, the report shall also be submitted annually to that council.
