<u>HB 926</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO SHORELINE SETBACK. Prohibits inclusion of accreted lands in determining shoreline setback line in counties with population over 500,000.	WLO, JUD
<u>HB 1486</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO SMALL BOAT HARBORS. Requires small boat harbor vessel permittees who, in the course of providing an excursion using state boating facilities, disembark fare-paying passengers in certain counties with the expectation that they will visit state property adjacent to quasi-public property during the excursion, to accompany passengers at all times while ashore.	WLO, JUD
<u>HB 1020, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR55)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE ALOHA TOWER DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION. Abolishes Aloha Tower Development Corporation (ATDC). Transfers the ATDC assets to the Hawaii Community Development Authority (HCDA). Establishes the Aloha Tower Complex under the jurisdiction of HCDA. Makes an appropriation. Effective on July 1, 2011. (HB1020 HD1)	TRN, WLO, FIN
<u>HB 324</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION. Establishes the South Kona wilderness area to be administered by the department of land and natural resources. Provides for the development of a comprehensive management plan for the area.	WLO, FIN



Prohibits the use of body crushing traps and non-padded or non-laminated foot or leg-hold traps and provides exemptions, regulates the use of snares and padded or laminated foot or leg-hold traps and provides exemptions, and establishes penalties for violations.
