HB1200	RELATING TO INFORMATION PRACTICES. Authorizes the release of names and salaries of undercover officers after five years from when the undercover officer ceases to work in an undercover capacity. Defines "undercover capacity" and "undercover officer".	JUD
HB1267	RELATING TO HEALTH CARE. Makes appropriations to the DHS and the Hawaii health systems corporation for the costs associated with Medicaid programs and comprehensive health care services, respectively.	FIN
HB1483	RELATING TO THE MOLOKAI IRRIGATION SYSTEM. Directs the Department of Agriculture to provide water to Molokai Irrigation System users who lease tracts of land under section 207 of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920, as amended, at a reduced rate. Requires the Department of Agriculture to forgive past due bills for the provision of irrigation water for Molokai homestead farmers.	HAW, FIN
