REQUESTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE STATE OF HAWAII AND THE ISLANDS OF POLYNESIA

Chair Awana, Vice Chair Hashem and Committee on International Affairs members:

The Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism (DBEDT) supports the intent of HCR 67 and HR 60, which seeks to establish a relationship between the State of Hawaii and the Islands of Polynesia.

An active relationship between the State of Hawaii and the political entities in the Pacific mentioned in the bill could result in increased educational and cultural exchange, and has the potential to create trade opportunities for Hawaii-based companies and organizations and reinforce the State of Hawaii's role as a major force for commerce and diplomatic relations in the Pacific. However, DBEDT respectfully reminds the committee that the State of Hawaii establishes sister-state relationships with states, provinces, prefectures or similar political subdivisions, and is willing to work with the East-West Center to identify a prospective candidate for sister relations from the list provided in the bill.
